THIS DEED, Made this 1st day of February, 1941, by
E.A. Kemp and Wife, Irene Kemp
of Franklin County and State of North Carolina, of the first part, to

Terrell E. Kemp
of Franklin County and State of North Carolina, of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That said E.A. Kemp and wife, Irene Kemp,
in consideration of One Dollar and other valuable consideration ~~DOLLARS~~, to
them paid by Terrell E. Kemp

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey to said
Terrell E. Kemp his heirs and assigns,

a certain tract or parcel of land in Franklin County, State of North Carolina,
adjoining the lands of Herman Kemp, Tolliver Kemp, Dorsett

and others, and bounded as follows, viz.:

Beginning on the south side of the Louisburg- White Level Road at an iron stake, corner
for Herman Kemp; thence along Herman Kems line, N 16°- 50' W, 2582.0 feet to an iron
stake in Tolliver Kems line, corner for Herman Kemp; thence along Tolliver Kems line,
N 80°-00 E, 978 feet to a stake corner for Tolliver Kemp and Dorsett; thence S°- 35' W 2407
feet to the center of the Louisburg- White Level Road, an iron stake on the North side,
corner for Dorsett; thence along said road, S 61° -20' W, 275.0 feet, S 50° -20' W 173.3
feet, S 38°- 50' W, 87.0 feet to the point of beginning and containing 39.5 acres, being
a part of the land deeded to Mrs. Irene Kemp by J.K. Dorsett and wife.
